

Student Satisfaction Survey – 2022 – 23

The student satisfaction survey of 2022-23 consisted of two major components – **campus satisfaction survey** and **student feedback on teachers**. The campus satisfaction survey was conducted to collect and analyze student opinion on various facilities offered by the institution. The following questionnaire was used to collect student feedback on the campus. Students were required to rate the variables on a five-point scale with ‘1’ indicating ‘poor’ and ‘5’ indicating ‘excellent’. The campus satisfaction survey was undertaken through MIS software. The results were analyzed and appropriate measures were taken for improvement.

Student feedback on teachers was taken using a questionnaire of fifteen questions where students were required to rate variables of the faculty member on a five point scale with ‘1’ indicating ‘strongly disagree’ and ‘5’ indicating ‘strongly agree’. The feedback survey was undertaken through MIS. The results of the survey were made accessible to individual teachers and the heads of departments through the MIS.
